Research funded by this call must be relevant to each PALOP's public health context and must be conducted locally. At the same time, it is expected to build a growing capacity in data science, epidemiology and public health in the PALOP.

We seek proposals that:

- Address a problem identified as a priority in a PALOP country or region;
- Promote innovation with secondary data to support decision makers and affected communities;
- Are designed to answer scientific questions related to women's and maternal health, including proposals that consider the impact of communicable diseases on this group;
- Have an implementation timeline of up to 12 months;
- Are driven by a commitment to open science and data sharing in such a way as to build a collaborative network to enable discoveries that will benefit people everywhere.
